

## **Community Evaluation and Research Manager**

McCreary Centre Society is seeking a **Community Evaluation and Research Manager** to undertake a range of evaluation and research projects, under the guidance of McCreary's Director of Evaluation.

Duties will include designing, coordinating and facilitating focus groups and interviews with diverse groups of youth across British Columbia. The applicant must be able to effectively and accurately collect and document information relevant to a number of different projects and be able to produce community-friendly reports of the findings.

The ideal candidate will have strong facilitation and organisational skills, a background working with marginalised youth, a strong knowledge of Indigenous culture and strong written and verbal communication skills. They will also have some knowledge of SPSS and the ability to conduct basic statistical analysis (Training can be provided if needed).

The position is ideal for a candidate with an interest and some experience in community-based research who is flexible and comfortable working in a fast-paced environment and who is able to quickly develop professional working relationships with youth and service providers.

Salary range is \$42,625–\$48,355 for 37.5 hrs per week. Employees are entitled to MSP and health benefits upon completion of 6 months' employment. Additional benefits include professional development and health and wellness funding, and an optional RRSP scheme.
